

## Tour H: Scandinavian City Break Stockholm & Copenhagen Friday 17 September—4 days

*Stockholm, the capital of Sweden: the home of the Nobel Prize, known as “the Scandinavian capital” and also the Green Capital 2010. Beautiful located on 14 islands with splendid view in all directions.*

- *The Vasa Museum: Tells the story and shows the Vasa ship, which sank on her maiden voyage.*
- *Gamla Stan: The Old Town, take a walk in the narrow streets and feel the past and present.*

*Copenhagen, the capital of Denmark: feel the heartbeat of a big city but still easy to explore by foot. Copenhagen was host for the climate congress in December 2009, and is also the place for discovering fashion, design, culture and gastronomy.*

- *Tivoli Gardens : the well known amusement park located in central Copenhagen.*
- *Nyhavn: the nice harbour area with charming, old houses and cosy restaurants.*

### **Day 1 (17.09.10) Oslo—Stockholm**

Flight SK 1484 at 18:20 from Oslo Airport Gardermoen to Stockholm airport Arlanda.

### **Day 2 (18.09.10) Stockholm**

The day is at own disposal. Possibility to join the optional tours:

#### **Option 1: Stockholm City Tour**

09:30-12:30 Meet your local guide and private coach at the hotel for a city tour and start with a visit to the Stockholm City Hall. After this visit, step back in time and take a stroll in Gamla Stan, Stockholm’s Old Town with its cobbled alleys, narrow streets, old houses, shops and church spires. Continue by coach to the Vasa Museum housing the wooden warship that sank in Stockholm Harbour during her ill-fated maiden voyage in 1628. The warship broke the surface of the harbour after 333 years on the bottom of the sea and is now on display in the Museum.

#### **Option 2: Visit Skansen - the oldest open air museum in the world**

14:00-17:00 Meet you local guide and private coach at the hotel for a visit to the open air museum of Skansen. The museum houses a unique collection of historical buildings from all over Sweden, as well as Scandinavian wild and domestic animals and exotic fauna at the Aquarium. Skansen has a lively town quarter, craft workshops, cafés, restaurants, shops, and a fantastic view of Stockholm.

#### **Option 3: Nobel Dinner at the City Hall**

19:00 Transfer from the hotel for evening dinner at Restaurant Stadshuskällären located in the Stockholm City Hall. Enjoy a Nobel Dinner in the same location, the same atmosphere and the same menu served as all the winners and royalties have enjoyed, a unique experience! Transfer back to the hotel after dinner.



# Tour H: Scandinavian City Break

## Day 3 (19.09.10) Stockholm—Copenhagen

10:21 Departure by train X2000 from Stockholm 2nd class.

15:30 Arrival Copenhagen.

Check in and overnight at Scandic Palace Hotel, [www.scandichotels.com](http://www.scandichotels.com)

### Option 1: Copenhagen City Sightseeing:

15:30-18:00 Meet your local guide and coach upon arrival at Copenhagen central station, and proceed on a 2,5 hours city sightseeing where you will see the city's sights as Christiansborg Palace, Nyhavn, and visit Amalienborg Palace. Tour ends at hotel and check in.

### Option 2: Guided City Tour by bike

15:30-17:30 Meet your local guide upon arrival at Copenhagen central station. Enjoy a special guided tour by bike. This is one of the best ways to get close to the sights. There are no steep hills and the distances are very reasonable. Your luggage will be transported to your hotel.

### Option 3: The Tivoli Gardens

19:00 Meet local guide in the hotel reception and walk (approx 5 min. walk) to Tivoli Garden. Guided walking tour in the Tivoli Gardens. The world-famous amusement park opened in 1843 and is one of the oldest gardens of its kind. One of the sights is a renowned wooden rollercoaster from 1914.  
20:00 Enjoy a Scandinavian dinner, in one of Tivoli's many restaurants. Time at own disposal after dinner.

## Day 4 (20.09.10) Departure Copenhagen

Individual transfer for flight home under own arrangement.

### Optional: Canal boat trip

09:00-11:00 Pick up at the hotel, and transfer by coach to Nyhavn Pier, for a trip with the regular canal boat. You will see the harbour and the idyllic canals of the capital, as well as beautiful churches, castles, picturesque old houses and architecturally modern buildings. Return to the pier and transfer by coach to hotel.

Continue to airport under own arrangement for departure from Copenhagen, or extend your stay in Copenhagen.
